

DMCA Notice And Takedown Policy

Kansas Fiber Network, LLC and its affiliated and member companies (collectively, “Company”) respect the intellectual property of others. If you believe that your copyrighted work has been copied and is accessible on a site that we host or operate in a way that constitutes copyright infringement, please notify us as follows:

(a) The Company’s Designated Agent for receipt of Notification of Claimed Infringement is:

(b) If you believe that material posted on any web site hosted by the Company infringes on your copyrights, you must send a written Notification of Claimed Infringement to the Designated Agent listed above containing the following information: (i) identification of the copyrighted work claimed to have been infringed in sufficient detail, (ii) identification of the material that is claimed to be infringing, and information sufficient to locate the material on the Internet, (iii) information on how to contact you (email address is preferred), (iv) a statement of your good faith belief that use of the material in the manner complained is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law, (v) a statement that the information in the notification is accurate, and under penalty of perjury, that you are the copyright owner or authorized to act on behalf of the copyright owner of the material that is allegedly infringed, and (vi) your name, phone number and physical or electronic signature. To the extent possible, you should also provide us with information sufficient to permit us to notify the owner/administrator/subscriber who posted the allegedly infringing material.

(c) Upon receipt of a Notification of Claimed Infringement that meets the requirements set forth above, the Company will promptly remove or block access to the allegedly infringing material, and the Company will then notify the subscriber/administrator who posted the material. Upon receipt of a notification that does not comply with the requirements listed above, but which substantially identifies the copyrighted material, the infringing material, and the copyright owner or its agent, the Company will take reasonable steps to assist in the receipt of a proper notification.

(d) If you receive notification from the Company that the Company has removed or blocked allegedly infringing material administrated, owned or posted by you, you may send a written counter-notification to the Designated Agent listed above. Your counter-notification must contain the following information: (i) your physical or electronic signature, (ii) identification of the material that has been blocked or removed and its location before the removal or blockage, (iii) a statement under penalty of perjury that you have a good faith belief that the removal or blockage was a result of mistake or misidentification of the material, and (iv) your name, address, phone number and a statement that you consent to the jurisdiction of the Federal District Court for the judicial district in which your address is located (or for the District

of Kansas, if your address is outside of the U.S.), and that you will accept service of process from the sender of the Notification of Claimed Infringement or its agent.

(e) Upon receipt of a counter-notification meeting the requirements set forth above, the Company will (i) promptly provide the complaining party a copy of the counter-notification, and inform the complaining party that the Company will unblock the material or restore it to its original location on the network in 10 business days, and (ii) unblock or restore the material no less than 10, nor more than 14, business days following the receipt of the counter-notification, unless the Company's Designated Agent first receives notice from the complaining party that the copyright owner has filed a court action seeking to restrain the alleged infringing activity relating to the material at issue.
